- Grant \$ Available:** \$11.52 million split into tiers:
Tier I: \$6.3 million
Tier II: \$5.2 million
- Grants Due:** Friday, February 12, 2010 by 11:59 PM EST
- How to Apply:** Online at www.grants.gov; cfda #:97.057
- Key program changes:** Security Plan/Vulnerability Assessment completion requirement (pre-application and/or completed within the last 3 years).
25% cash or in-kind match requirement
Management & administration costs may not exceed 5% of project total.
- Allowable Projects:** Training or Exercises
Security Plan /Vulnerability Assessment Development
Vehicle/Driver Security
Facility Security
Passenger Screening
- Grant Eligibility:** Tier I- Bus Operators with fleets of more than 250 buses.
Tier II- 1) Charter bus operators taking more than 50 trips to FY 2009 UASI areas
2) Fixed route bus operators with services to FY 2009 UASI areas

All vehicle security improvements must be made to over-the-road buses, which are defined as vehicles that have an elevated passenger deck located over a baggage compartment and are capable of carrying 30 or more passengers, within a vehicle of at least 35 feet in length
- Other Info:** Requested information to verify tier eligibility includes:
1) Total number of over-the-road buses operating in service.
2) Total number of over-the-road buses in eligible service categories, area of operations, number of passengers, number of employees, number of facilities, etc.
3) The number of over-the-road buses utilized in each eligible service category and the UASI jurisdiction(s) being served.
4) A source which would allow DHS to verify fleet size, such as standard inventory documents, insurance policies on covered buses, copies of Unified Carrier Registrations, Single State Registrations, DOT numbers, etc.
