PREPARE FOR A SAFE SCHOOL YEAR

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 36% of school-age pedestrians from 2006 to 2015 were fatally injured by another vehicle in school transportation-related crashes. Since school buses are among the safest modes of transport, it's when children are walking to a bus stop or getting on or off a bus that they are most at risk of being hit by other vehicles. As we start a new school year, school vehicles are back on the roads. Here are a few safety tips for a successful return.

- 1. Allow for extra time to get time to get to your destination.
- Obey all posted speed limits in school zones.
- 3. Stay alert! Watch for children crossing and do not block a crosswalk.4. Be aware of distracted teens walking.
- 5. Keep your distance when driving behind a school vehicle and watch for yellow lights. Yellow lights indicate a stop is imminent.
- 6. Stop when you see red! Motorists must stop for a school bus or school transport vehicle stopped with red lights flashing whether it is on your side of the road, the opposite side of the road, or at an intersection you are approaching.
- 7. Never pass a school vehicle on the right.
