Plymouth Motor Coach Parking

Plymouth's most visited attraction, Plimoth Plantation (exit 4 off route 3 south and exit 5 off route 3 north, to exit 4) has ample free parking in their Bus and Motor Coach Parking depending on time of year. The lot is within walking distance to the Harry Hornblower II Visitor Center. Follows signs to Plimoth Plantation and to the Coach lot.

Most other Plymouth attractions including *Mayflower II* and whale watching are located 3 miles north of Plimoth Plantation along route 3A, in Plymouth Center and on Water Street, 1 block down hill from route 3A.

Passengers are dropped off at the crescent at State Pier (Pilgrim Memorial State Park) directly in front of *Mayflower II*. Once passengers have disembarked, coaches travel five blocks north on Water Street to the bus/coach parking lot at the base of Lothrop and Nelson Streets.
